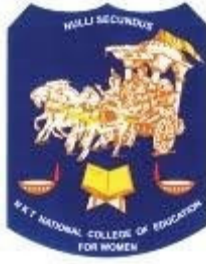

## **Master of Education (M.Ed.) Programme**

### **1. Eligibility**

A Woman candidate shall be eligible for admission to the programme leading to the Degree of Master of Education provided he/she has passed a Bachelors Degree Examination in Education of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University or some other University recognized by the Syndicate as equivalent there to, with a minimum of 50% marks in theory and practical separately.

The basis of selection of candidate for admission shall be based on the existing regulations of the University/ Government of Tamil Nadu. Reservation of seats and

other concessions for the SC, ST, MBC, DNC, BC and other special categories of candidates notified by the Government of Tamil Nadu shall be provided in accordance with the statutory provisions of the Government of Tamil Nadu in force from time to time.

No candidate shall be eligible for the Degree of M.Ed. unless he/she has completed the prescribed course of study and has passed the qualifying examination and has satisfied the Examiners in a dissertation. The programme of study shall be the duration of two years.

## 2. Physical Fitness

- a) No candidate will be admitted who is physically unfit enough to pursue this programme.
- b) A certificate of physical fitness obtained from a Government Civil Surgeon/ Civil Assistant Surgeon must be produced as evidence of physical fitness at the time of admission.

### Note:

1. Particular attention will be paid by the authorities of the College with respect to the minimum Physical fitness requirements, as Physical Education a mandatory part of the M.Ed. Programme.
2. All the above eligibility conditions are likely to change, based on the release of the Government order pertaining to M.Ed. admissions for the ensuing academic year.

#### **4. Registration**

The duty filled in application should be submitted to The Principal, N.K.T. National College of Education for Women, Chennai – 600 005, on or before the due date along with the attested photo copies of the following:

- 1) S.S.L.C. First page/ Plus Two Mark sheet for age proof
- 2) B.Ed. Degree Certificate and Mark Sheets
- 3) Community Certificate
- 4) Ex-servicemen Certificate from an authorized district level official
- 5) Physically Handicapped Certificate
- 6) Transfer Certificate

#### **5. Selection Norms**

Eligible applicants will be provisionally selected by the Admission Committee on the basis of merit according to the rules of reservation of seats and other norms as prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu from time to time. Candidates selected for admission will be informed by post under certificate of posting with a copy put up on the College notice board.

Candidates called for provisional admission have to report at the specified time and date with the following certificates in original:

1. S.S.L.C. Book/ Mark Sheet
2. Plus Two Mark Sheet
3. B.Ed. Mark Sheets and Degree Certificate
4. Community Certificate from a Deputy Tahsildar with designation stamp & round seal.
5. Transfer and Conduct Certificates from the College last studied.
6. Ex-servicemen Certificate from an authorized district level official
7. Physically handicapped Certificate should be obtained from the Medical Officer and the same shall be produced at the time of admission.
8. Physical fitness Certificate should be obtained from the Medical Officer and produced at the time of admission.

The candidate must be ready to remit the College fee as directed. The selection of the candidate will be cancelled, if she fails

- (i) to report at the specified time and date
- (ii) to bring all the certificates in original
- (iii) to remit the College fee as directed and
- (iv) if there is any discrepancy in the application and the originals.

## **6. Probation and Leave**

- (i) Each student will be on probation for 60 working days from the date of admission. The students should not appear for any examination other than those prescribed by the College during the programme.
- (ii) Students will not ordinarily be granted any leave in advance or in continuation of the mid-term/ Christmas/ Pongal or any other scheduled holidays.
