Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) In Education

Full - Time

1. Eligibility

- a) Candidates who have qualified for Post-Graduate Degree in Education of Tamilnadu Teachers Education University or any University recognized by the Syndicate as equivalent thereto prior to 1st January 1991, subject to such conditions as may be prescribed there for shall be eligible to register for the Degree of Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) in Education and undergo the prescribed course of study in this institution.
- b) Candidates who have qualified for Post-Graduate Degree in Education

mentioned in Regulation 1 (a) supra on or after 1st January 1991, shall be required to have obtained minimum of 55 % of marks in their Post-Graduate Degree in Education to become eligible to register for the Degree of Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) in Education and to undergo the prescribed course of study in this institution.

c) Concession of 5% marks will be given for SC/ST candidates.

2. Duration

The duration of the M.Phil course shall extend over a period of one academic year consisting of two semesters for the full time students and two academic years for the part-time students.

3. Course of Study

The course of study for the M.Phil degree shall consist of

- (a) Part-I comprising two written papers and Preliminary Dissertation Work
- (b) Part-II comprising of one written paper according to the syllabi duly approved by the Board of Studies from time to time and Dissertation.

Part I shall consist of Paper 1– Advanced Research Methodology and Educational Statistics, a Back-ground paper relating to the proposed dissertation for which Examination will be conducted internally by the College and Preliminary Dissertation Work.

Part II consists of Paper 2– Contemporary Evolution in Indian Education and submission of Dissertation.

4. Physical Fitness

- a) No candidate will be admitted who is physically unfit enough to pursue this programme.
- b) A certificate of physical fitness obtained from a Government Civil Surgeon/Civil Assistant Surgeon must be produced as evidence of physical fitness at the time of admission.

Note:

- 1. Particular attention will be paid by the authorities of the College with respect to the minimum physical fitness requirements, as Physical Education is a mandatory part of the M.Phil. Programme.
- 2. All the above eligibility conditions are likely to change, based on the release of the Government order pertaining to M.Phil. admissions for the ensuing academic year.

6. Registration

The duly filled in applicationshould be submitted to The Principal, N.K.T. National College of Education for Women, Chennai – 600 005, on or before the due date along with the attested photo copies of the following:

- 4. Ex-servicemen Certificate from an authorized district level official

- 6. Transfer Certificate

7. Selection Norms

Eligible applicants will be provisionally selected by the Admission Committee on the basis of merit according to the rules of reservation of seats and other norms as prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu from time to time. Candidates selected for admission will be informed by post under certificate of posting with a copy put up on the College notice board.

Candidates called for provisional admission have to report at the specified time and date with the following certificates in original:

- 1. S.S.L.C. Book/ Mark Sheet
- 2. Plus Two Mark Sheet
- 3. B.Ed. & M.Ed. Mark Sheets and Degree Certificate
- 4. Community Certificate from a Deputy Tahsildar with designation stamp & round seal.
- 5. Transfer and Conduct Certificates from the College last studied.

- 6. Ex-servicemen Certificate from an authorized district level official
- 7. Physically handicapped Certificate should be obtained from the Medical Officer and the same shall be produced at the time of admission.
- 8. Physical fitness Certificate should be obtained from the Medical Officer and produced at the time of admission.

The candidate must be ready to remit the College fee as directed. The selection of the candidate will be cancelled, if she fails

- i. to report at the specified time and date
- ii. to bring all the certificates in original
- iii. to remit the College fee as directed and
- iv. if there is any discrepancy in the application and the originals.

8. Probation and Leave

- a) Each student will be on probation for 60 working days from the date of admission. The students should not appear for any examination other than those prescribed by the College during the programme.
- b) Students will not ordinarily be granted any leave in advance or in continuation of the mid-term/ Christmas/ Pongal or any other scheduled holidays.

9. M.Phil. Programme

- develop proficiency in dissertation work and conduct research systematically (MPHDR).

10. Eligibility

Teacher candidates working in affiliated Colleges or in Departments of the University or in Polytechnic approved by the Department of Technical Education or in approved Higher Secondary Schools as well as High Schools under State Board or Central Board or Education Instructors of Indian Armed Force who possess the qualifications prescribed in regulation 1 supra, shall be eligible to register for the degree of Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) in Education and undergo the prescribed course of study in this institution.

11. Duration

The course of study shall extend over a period of two academic years. The examination for Part I shall be taken at the end of first academic year and Part II, at the end of second academic year. The Regulations governing the Full - time M.Phil. Programme in Education with regard to the course of study, scheme of examination, passing minimum and qualifications of Guide conducting the M.Phil. Programme in Education shall apply to part-time candidates also.
