## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Preamble

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between N.K.T. National College of Education for Women (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai - 600 005 and Department of Educational Psychology, Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Chennai - 97. This Memorandum of Understanding is executed at Chennai on 26/03/2021 through the Chief functionaries of the parties.

**I. N.K.T. National College of Education for Women** is situated at the heart of the Chennai city at Triplicane. The College is built in an area of 3.06 acres, where a model school is also housed. Established in the year 1966 by Sriman N.K. Thirumalachariar, a visionary and a philanthropist, it has evolved into a well - established College catering to the teacher education needs of women from all sections of the society. The College offers both graduate and postgraduate courses in Education with Autonomous status awarded by the University Grants Commission in the year 1988. In thirty three years after autonomy, the College has grown upright to great heights as an institution of higher learning in education. N.K.T. National College of Education for Women has also fallen in line with to NAAC peer team evaluation and it was awarded a five star status in the first cycle and awarded A Grade with CGPA of 3.26 on a 4 point scale in the second cycle. In its continuous striving for excellence over five decades in achieving position '*Second to None*', the institution has been successful. The College, in this 55<sup>th</sup> year of its existence, with 33 years of autonomy, remains fully aware and committed to its mission of empowering young women student teachers to face life and its multifarious challenges at both personal and professional levels.

**II** And Whereas the **Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University** is an exclusive University for Teacher Education established in 2008, by the Government of Tamil Nadu (Act No 33 of 2008) to promote excellence in Teacher Education. This University is unique in nature relatively to the other Universities since its assignment is to promote excellence in teacher education and produce dynamic and smart teachers for the benefit of the society and the nation at large, with six Departments of Study and Research namely: *Department of Pedagogical Sciences, Department of Value Education, Department of Educational Psychology, Department of Educational Technology, Department of Curriculum Planning and Evaluation, and Department of Educational Planning and Administration.* Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University produces M.Ed., M.Phil., and Ph.D. Scholars every year through the University Departments as well as through its affiliated Colleges of Education in Tamil Nadu.

## **1. Purpose and Objectives:**

The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and interaction towards the empowerment of teachers and students. Hence, the parties desire to work together with the following objectives:

- 1.1. To conduct and organize students' interchanging/intercultural programme integrations without financial dependencies.*
- 1.2. To create job opportunities, global openings and other possibilities without any financial dependencies.*
- 1.3. To encourage the Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors and others to participate and contribute as resource faculty for Webinars, Seminars, Mentoring Programmes, etc.*
- 1.4. To establish a global stage for the students and teachers.*
- 1.5. To strengthen the educational relationships between the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and N.K.T. National College of Education for Women (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai – 05 for the welfare of the students and teachers.*


## **2. Discretion:**


This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:


- 2.1. That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and the Secretary of N.K.T. National College of Education for Women (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai – 05.*
- 2.2. That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties/Institutions.*
- 2.3. The Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and N.K.T. National College of Education for Women (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai – 05 agree that this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual agreement and that each institution may unilaterally withdraw after three months' notice to the partner.*
- 2.4. The functionaries shall meet at least once in three months for planning and implementation of the programmes via video conference or face to face based on everyone's availability.*


