Preamble

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between N.K.T. National College of Education for Women, (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai, Tamilnadu, India and Ambal Tamil Sangam., Door No. 1, Villa No. 8, Zonal No. 90, Al Salah Next to Masjid, Al Wakhra Main Road Doha, Qatar. This Memorandum of Understanding is executed at Chennai on 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 through the Chief functionaries of the parties.

**I. N.K.T. National College of Education for Women** is situated at the heart of the Chennai city at Triplicane. The College is built in an area of 3.06 acres, where a model school is also housed. Established in the year 1966, by Sriman N.K. Thirumalachariar, a Visionary & a Philanthropist, it has evolved into a well-established College catering to the teacher education needs of women from all sections of the society. The College offers both graduate and postgraduate courses in Education with Autonomous status awarded by the University Grants Commission in the year 1988. In thirty three years after Autonomy, the College has grown upright to great heights as an institution of higher learning in Education. N.K.T. National College of Education for Women has also fallen in line with NAAC peer team evaluation and it was awarded a five star status in the first cycle and awarded A Grade with CGPA of 3.26 on a 4 point scale in the second cycle. In its continuous striving for excellence over five decades in achieving position '*Second to None*', the institution has been successful. The College, in this 55<sup>th</sup> year of its existence, with 33 years of autonomy, remains fully aware and committed to its mission of empowering young women student teachers to face life and its multifarious challenges at both personal and professional levels.

**II. Aambal Tamil Sangam Qatar (ATSQ)** was started in 2020. The Main MOTO of this ATSQ is connecting with the various institutions as schools, colleges and universities. It creates a great opportunity to shape and enlighten knowledge for the upcoming generation. ATSQ has conducted various awareness programs which are very suitable for the current situation. ATSQ has conducted Debate entitled on "Mobile phone's usage", "100 percent voting", "corona awareness program", are few examples of the debates. ATSQ has done many world record events and encouraging others, like the youngsters, students, Teachers & the Professors etc. also to do the world record events.

Recent achievement was conducting a world record event by coordinating with 512 professors from 232 Colleges from fifty plus countries across the globe. The Virtual Academic Festival with More Colleges & the Professors record has been made in 127 hours nonstop and telecasted LIVE in American Television. ATSQ has conducted many events such as Sollarangam, Kaviyarangam, Isaiyarangam. Etc. ATSQ has done a new world record event called '**ARIVOM AAYIRAM**' which has shown the lights on great books and the literature which has forgotten by the people. Around 800 doctorates have referred and reviewed around 800 plus books and had shown the lime lights on great books and classical literature which had been forgotten by the people. This program had brought the great asserts of our country to the lime light had taken it to the next level of reading the good books via story telling method by the experts. These books have been

explained in details by the professors of various colleges in our Channel on daily basis and sharing their great experiences and delivering to the next generation through ONLINE. This is an excellent platform for the students who are among schools; colleges started learning through ONLINE mode during this pandemic.

#### **1. Purpose and Objectives:**

The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and interaction towards the empowerment of students and teachers. Hence, the parties desire to work together with the following objectives:

1. To organize and conduct Online/ Offline Webinars, Seminars, Mentoring Programs, Student exchanging / intercultural programmes without financial dependencies;
2. To enhance the teaching and learning activities.
3. To facilitate collaborative learning among the Teacher Educators.
4. To encourage Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors and others to participate and contribute as Resource Experts in the online media platform for Education related activities and programs.
5. To conduct programs for students that would improve their personality, emotional well-being and to empower them with career options.
6. To establish a global stage for students and teachers for all education and education related activities like Storytelling, Poem writing, Debate, Elocution etc. in the online media platform
7. To strengthen the educational relationship between Aambal Tamil Sangam and N.K.T. National College of Education for Women, for the welfare of students, teachers and community at large.

#### **2. Discretion:**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

1. That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Secretary and principal of N.K.T. National College of Education for Women, Chennai and the Head & Managing Director Aambal Tamil Sangam.

2. That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties/ Institutions.
3. The N.K.T. National College of Education for Women and Aambal Tamil Sangam agree that this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual agreement and that each institution may unilaterally withdraw after three months' notice to the partner.
4. The functionaries shall meet at least once in three months for planning and implementation of the programmes via video conference or face to face mode based on the availability.


