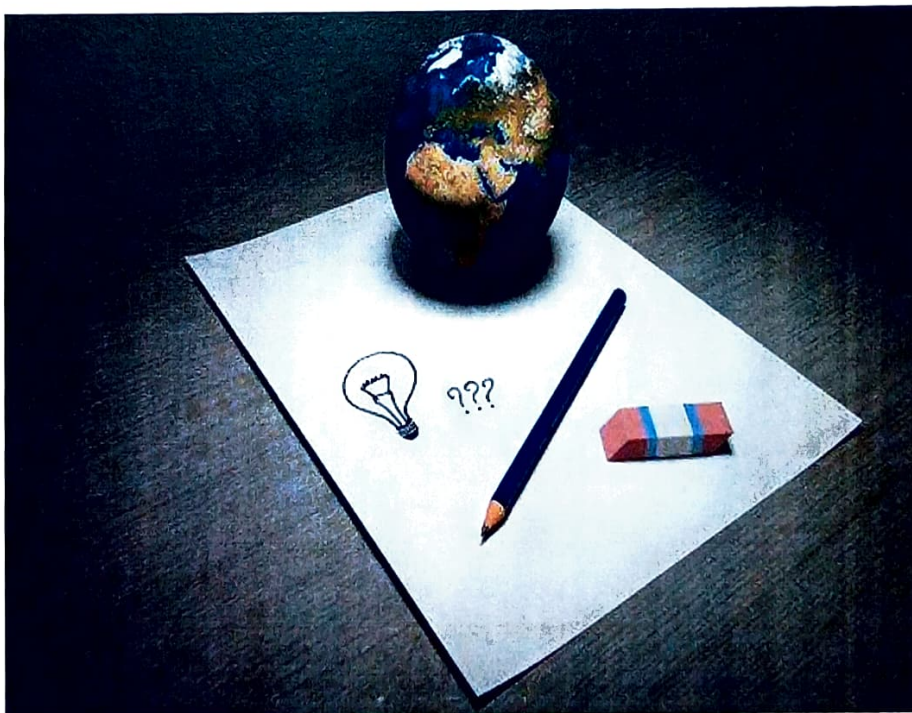

Stage-1: Planning

(i) Preparation of the Group
