

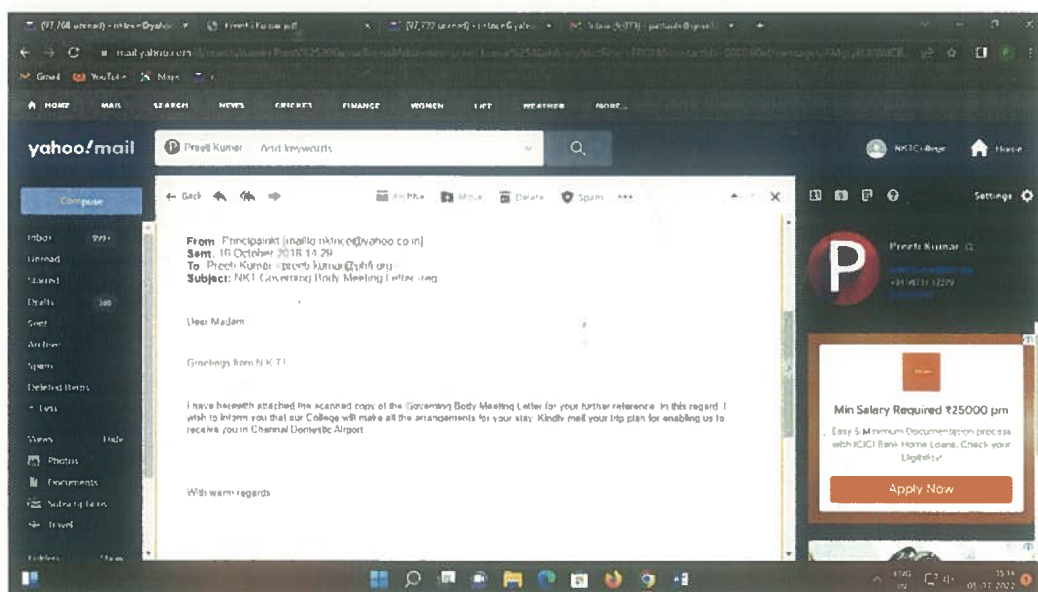

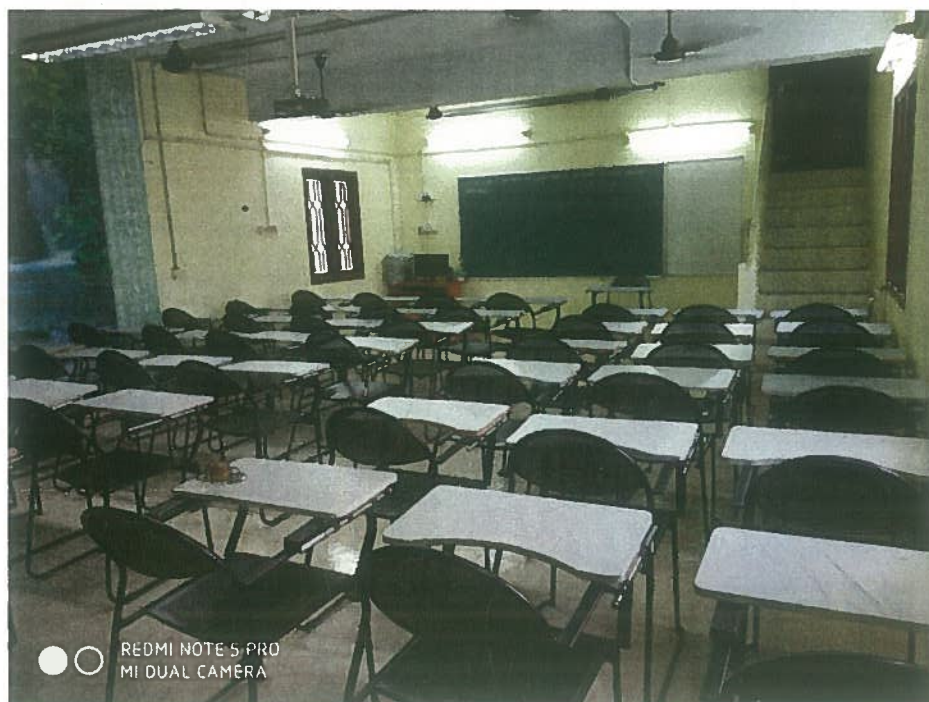
N.K.T. National College of Education, Chennai is trying its best to keep pace with the

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recent applications of e-governance in terms of various functions being performed digitally through internet. The necessary infrastructure is provided partly by the UGC Autonomous Grant and partly by the College Management, Sriman N.K. Thirumalachariar National Education Society, Chennai. Teaching Faculty members, Non-Teaching Staff and Students use computers, laptops, smart phones and other e-devices to utilize the benefits of modern day technologies available in the field of Higher Education. Students have been provided SIM Cards by the State Government to facilitate the use of technology in teaching-learning and evaluation.

A well-equipped IT Admin Unit has been established in the College to monitor and regulate computerization of all academic, financial and administrative activities related with the College, Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education, Ministry of Education, University Grants Commission (UGC), National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), Office of the Regional Joint Director (RJD), Directorate of Collegiate Education (DC) and other Educational Institutions and any other government agency. The e-Governance & Admin Unit Coordinator shall coordinate the data collection and uploading activities by preparing and observing the prescribed schedules.

3. Finance and Accounts

Annual budget is meticulously prepared using TALLY software which helps to streamline the budget under different heads such as College Accounts, Examination Accounts and so on.

4. Student Support and Progression

Admission to B.Ed. Programme is realized through Single Window Counselling since 2012-2013. Online admission and support activities include the following:

- Circulation of timetable and other related activities through whatsapp groups
- Library has AutoLib software system and open access system
- Bar code facility in vogue at the College Library
- e - resource, N-List, INFLIBNET, and e - journal are in vogue


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- The technology laboratory in the hostel permits hostel students to undertake online courses on SWAYAM platform
- Classrooms and Halls with LCD projectors
- Smart Interactive White Board
- Biometric / digital attendance for students



Above digital functions are realized online through internet with support of ICT based infrastructure available in the College.

5. Examination System

Under the scheme of autonomy, there is a fully computerized Examination Unit. The digital features of the Examination unit include: Technology facilitates an easy interface in the timely publication of results.

The College administration is committed to have an automated examination system based on features of e-governance for bringing reliability & efficiency in the system.
