The Bachelor of Special Education programme, generally known as B.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment) is a professional course that prepares teachers for upper primary or middle level (classes VI to VIII), secondary level (classes IX-X) and senior secondary level classes (XI-XII) and resource teachers for all levels.

1. ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility for admission to the course is based on the guidelines of the Government of Tamilnadu, Tamilnadu Teachers Education University and Rehabilitation Council of India in force from time to time.

MASTER OF EDUCATION (M.Ed.) PROGRAMME 2016-2017

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR THE COURSE

A Woman candidate shall be eligible for admission to the course leading to the Degree of Master of Education provided he/she has passed a Bachelors Degree Examination in Education of this University or some other University recognized by the Syndicate as equivalent thereto, with a minimum of 50% marks in theory and practical separately.

The basis of selection of candidate for admission shall be based on the existing regulations of the University / Government of Tamil Nadu. Reservation of seats and other concessions for the SC, ST, MBC, DNC, BC and other special categories of candidates notified by the Government of Tamil Nadu shall be provided in accordance with the statutory provisions of the Government of Tamil Nadu in force from time to time.

No candidate shall be eligible for the Degree of M.Ed. unless he/she has completed the prescribed course of study and has passed the qualifying examination and has satisfied the Examiners in a dissertation.

2. DURATION

The course of study shall be for the duration on ONE academic year. There will be 10 days for admission and another 10 days for examination exclusively. The entire course work will be for 1080 Hours.

3. REGISTRATION

Application correctly and completely filled in should be submitted to The Principal, N.K.T. National College of Education for Women, Chennai – 600 005, on or before 17.08.2011 along with the attested Xerox copies of the following.

4. ADMISSION

Eligible applicants will be provisionally selected by the admission committee on the basis of merits according to the rules of reservation of seats and other norms prescribed by Government of Tamil Nadu from time to time. Candidates selected for admission will be informed by post under certificate of posting with a copy put up on the college notice board.

Candidates called for provisional admission have to report at the specified time and date with the following certificates in original:

MASTER OF PHILOSOPHY (M.Phil.) PROGRAMME 2016-2017

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR THE COURSE

Full time (One Year)

Woman candidate with a Master's degree in Education of Tamilnadu Teachers Education University or any other University recognized by the Syndicate as equivalent thereto, provided that those who have qualified for Master's Degree prior to 1st January 1991 must have secured a minimum of 50 percent of marks and those who have qualified for the Master's degree on or after 1st January 1991 must have secured a minimum of 55 percent of marks. For SC/ST, Physically Handicapped & Visually Challenged candidates who have qualified on or after 1st January 1991 a concession of 5 percent of marks shall be given in the minimum eligibility marks.

Full time (One Year)

(i) Teachers working in the University Department / (ii) Teachers working in affiliated colleges whose qualification are approved by the University/ (iii) Non-Teacher candidates are eligible to M.Phil. Part time degree course./ (iv) Teachers of Polytechnics approved by the Director of the Technical Education or Teachers of Higher Secondary and High Schools approved either State Board or Central Board of Secondary Education or Educational Instructors of IAF (Within the boundary of Chennai) are eligible for admission to M.Phil. part time degree course provided if they have secured 55% of marks in their Masters degree obtained on or after 1.1.'91 and no minimum marks is prescribed in their Masters Degree obtained prior to 1.1.'91. For SC/ST, Handicapped & Visually Challenged candidates who have qualified on or after 1st January 1991 a concession of 5 percent of marks shall be given in the minimum eligibility marks.

2. CONDITIONS FOR SELECTION

1. There will be an Entrance Examination for Full time M.Phil course conducted by the college.



2. Applicants for Full time M.Phil. Programme should attend the Entrance Examination only in the subject for which he/she applied for and not in the subject qualified by him/her.
3. The entrance Examination will be for 50 marks. The marks of the qualifying Examination will be reduced to 50 and added to the entrance marks for ranking in selection.
4. There will be No entrance for Part time M.Phil. applicants.
5. For Part Time Teacher Candidate the distance between the place of employment and the college where M.Phil. is conducted should be such that the candidate can travel everyday and attend classes regularly on working days.
6. Teacher candidates seeking admission to Part time M.Phil. Programme should produce a certificate approving their qualification/appointment as teacher in the College/Polytechnic/School concerned from the competent authorities i.e. University of Madras for Director of Technical Education/DEO or IMS or Inspector of Anglo Indian Schools or Secretary, CBSE respectively.
