The Environmental Sustainability Monitoring Committee met the Advisory Board online on 3rd September 2020 at 4.00 pm. to discuss about the maintenance of the College campus during lockdown.

The meeting commenced with invocation and the Principal welcomed all the members of the Environmental Sustainability Monitoring Committee present for the meeting.

Principal informed that the Rotary Club of Chennai, IT City have started the renovation of Rest Rooms attached to the Computer Block and will be completing in a month's time by October 2021 and the members of the Environmental Sustainability Committee are ensuring that the debris are removed on a day to day basis and the campus is maintained clean.

The members of the Environmental Sustainability Committee reported to the Advisory Board that there are few minor electrical repairs to be attended in the College Annexe Block. There is not adequate lighting in the Verandas of the College Annexe Block. The advisory Committee after discussion asked to proceed with the electrical repairs and fix additional lights in the verandas.

The members of the Environmental Sustainable Monitoring Committee reported that the Rain Water Harvesting System is due for cleaning. After discussion it was

suggested by the Advisory Board to clean up the Rain Water Harvesting System and also to number it for easy maintenance. The sweepers were appreciated for good maintenance of all the drains even during the lockdown.

The Members also reported the minor plumbing repairs to be attended at the College Annexe Block and Vijayanthimala Block. After discussion the Advisory Board gave suggestions about the quality of taps to be replaced at the toilets and an additional wash basin to be fixed at the Vijayanthimala Block.

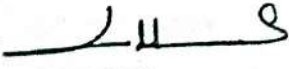

The Environmental Sustainability Monitoring Committee met the Advisory Board online on 29th November 2019 at 4.30 pm. to discuss about the maintenance of the College campus.

The meeting commenced with invocation and the Principal welcomed all the members of the Environmental Sustainability Monitoring Committee present for the meeting and thanked the Rotary Club of Chennai, IT City for inaugurating the Rain Water Harvesting Units installed in the campus costing Rs. 2,00,000/- and thanked Dr. K. Vijaya, Assistant Professor of Education for all initiatives taken to get the support of Rotary Club for sustaining the campus.

It was reported by Dr. T. Sahaya Salla, Co-ordinator of the Environmental Sustainability Committee that the restrooms adjoining the Madabosee Sudarasanam Iyengar Hall and Padma Bhushan Dr. Sarojini Varadappan Hall are not in a good condition and needs a complete renovation. It was discussed with the members and with the suggestions from Technical support members it was decided to completely renovate the two sets of restrooms. Considering the renovation cost, Principal suggested that Non-Governmental Organizations can be approached for support.

Student members Ms. S. Srija and Ms. M. Gokila Priya informed the initiation of the Go Green Project of the College. They thanked the Secretary, Principal and Teaching Faculty members for motivating them to start such projects in the campus to maintain a healthy atmosphere. They also thanked the Administrative Staff

members for all their support in the launch of the Project on 6th December 2021. They requested the College Secretary to initiate the project and thanked all donors for donating plants and boards to be placed around the campus.

It was informed that the College has tentatively planned to organize a Community Awareness Programme Parambariya Unavvu Thiruvizha to bring awareness about healthy foods among students and all in the nearby community. It has been planned in a very large scale with competitions and cultural all related to healthy and traditional food preparations. It was discussed about the arrangements to be made to maintain the campus clean and disposal of waste from time to time. Suggestions were given and discussed about safe entry of people from nearby community, restroom cleanliness and maintenance and safe disposal of waste. Similar arrangements for other celebrations like Uzhavar Thirunal and Inter-Collegiate Competitions (EDUFEST) were discussed.

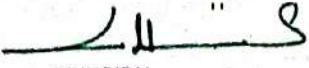
It was also informed that the College has scheduled a UGC Autonomous Grant Extension Activities: Training in Bio-degradable Waste Management Programme has been scheduled on 3rd February 2020 to create awareness on management of Bio-degradable waste among the women in community. It was suggested to install more number of vermin-compost pits to make use of the degradable waste and produce pure chemical-free manure in the campus.

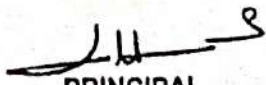
Suggestions for paperless Office was also discussed and recommended for economical usage to reduce wastage at source.

The Committee suggested provision for waste water recycling. It was discussed to recycle the water from the RO Plant to be used to water plants in the campus and in the Restrooms. As the waste water from the RO Plants is quite a huge volume it was discussed and agreed to do the needful to make adequate arrangements to make use of the waste water and be recycled for further use. Minor electrical and plumbing repairs were discussed with the electrician and plumber in detail.

The Environmental Sustainability Monitoring Committee met the Advisory Board online on 3rd September 2019 at 4.30 pm. to discuss about the maintenance of the College campus.

The meeting commenced with invocation and the Principal welcomed all the members of the Environmental Sustainability Monitoring Committee present for the meeting.

Dr. T. Sahaya Salla, Co-ordinator of the Environmental Sustainability Committee reported that there are only two rain water harvesting units in the campus and more number of such units are required for sustainability of the campus. It was discussed with the Technical Support Staff about the feasibility of installing more Rain Water Harvesting Units in the campus. It was also informed that Dr. K. Vijaya, Assistant Professor of Education has approached the Rotary Club of Chennai, IT City to support instituting more number of Rain Water Harvesting in the College Campus.

It was reported that students have initiated to plant more number of trees and plants and have approached philanthropic donors and are also scheduling awareness programmes for students and community people to maintain a healthy environment.

It was informed that the pipelines connecting the taps in the restrooms at the first and second floors of Vijayanthimala Block has to be attended as the flow of water is

very thin and leakages have also been identified at few points. It was discussed and was suggested to be immediately attended to as it is very important to conserve water.

It was reported that the Central Main Stage at the Padma Bhushan Dr. Sarojini Varadappan Hall needs to be attended as it has damages at the central part of the stage and the lights have to be replaced. It was discussed and was suggested to be attended at the earliest after working out on the cost and the lights were suggested to be replaced with LED lights for saving power and better lighting.

It was reported that the photocopying machine at the College Central Library needs to be serviced as papers are getting stuck very frequently and each time the machine has to be restarted leading to increased consumption of power. It was discussed and as the photocopying machine at the Central Library is very important and is being used extensively, it was decided to call for servicing and to meet with the repairs after getting the cost approval from the Purchase and Maintenance Committee.

It was reported that the College has decided to initiate the Centres of Excellence and Outreach for the benefit of the students and all stakeholders in the community. It was recommended that minor repairs have to be attended at the centres with painting and lighting repairs and replacements. It was discussed and required arrangements were suggested and the members recommended for awareness programmes pertaining to environmental sustainability through NKT Centre for Outreach.

It was reported that the grill railings in the steps at the College Block and other buildings needs to be attended as it has become little rusted and at times causes minor damages to people passing by. It was asked to be attended immediately. Welding repair and painting was suggested.

It was reported that the Pedagogy of English Classroom floor tile are damaged with flooring cracks. It was discussed to be very dangerous and was suggested to call for quotations from three different civil contractors and then be finalized in the Purchase and Maintenance Committee. The disposal of such debris was also discussed and agreed upon.

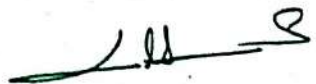
It was reported that some of the restroom doors have to be attended to prevent from further termite damages. It was discussed and a detailed report was asked to be prepared for termite treatment.

It was informed that more number of bins to segregate waste have been put up in additional places around the campus and the student representatives also ensured that students have been made aware of segregation and importance of maintaining the campus clean and healthy.

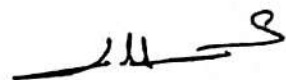
It was also informed that students are preparing posters to be fixed near taps in hand wash stations to inform stake holders to be aware of limited availability of natural resources and to conserve them.

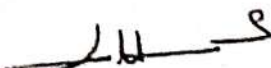
Suggestions for paperless Office was also discussed and recommended for economical usage to reduce wastage at source.

The Environmental Sustainability Monitoring Committee met the Advisory Board online on 24th June 2021 at 4.30 pm. to discuss about the maintenance of the College campus.

The meeting commenced with invocation and the Principal welcomed all the members of the Environmental Sustainability Monitoring Committee present for the meeting to report their observations and requirements to the Advisory Board for maintaining the College Campus.

Principal, Dr. S. Chamundeswari informed that Dr. S. Malathi, Dean of Academics has approached Non-Governmental Organizations for support to renovate the Restrooms in the Shri C.R. Pattabiraman Block and the Handwash Area attached to the Dining Hall in the College Hostel. She requested the College Secretary, Dr. M. Arumugam to help in getting approval from Chennai Corporation for the renovation. It was discussed and the Secretary ensured adequate support from the Management for renovation.

The members of the Environmental Sustainability Committee reported to the Advisory Board that the cleaning of the underground water storage units (sumps) and over head tanks needs to be cleaned for periodic maintenance. It was discussed

and was advised to carryout the periodic cleaning and maintenance immediately and not to wait until the College reopens for in-campus classes.

The members reported that as the College hostel is closed due to the pandemic situation, some of the hostel doors of restrooms are found to be affected by termite and needs attention at the earliest. It was discussed that such treatments are done immediately after identification of such issues and was also reported by the members of the Environmental Sustainability Monitoring Committee, that adequate care is taken by Mrs. B. Amuthavalli, Hostel Care-taker and maintenance unit with regard to maintenance of College Hostel. Minor Plumbing repairs were also suggested to ensure that there is no water leaking anywhere in the College Hostel. The members also reported that the Hostel Kitchen and Canteen though are kept closed are being periodically cleaned and maintained by the Catering Unit.

Dr. T. Sahaya Saila reported that the all plants are watered and well maintained in the campus but the playground needs to be attended as grass has grown here and there and making water to stagnate in small pools during downpour of rain. It was suggested by the Advisory Committee to fix additional lights after the renovation, which would be during the upcoming semester.

Water management and recycling of waste water was discussed and ensured that the system is working efficiently.

The waste management strategies at the College campus were discussed and the Advisory Board appreciated the support staff in-charge of cleaning and maintenance of campus for their committed work.

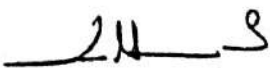
