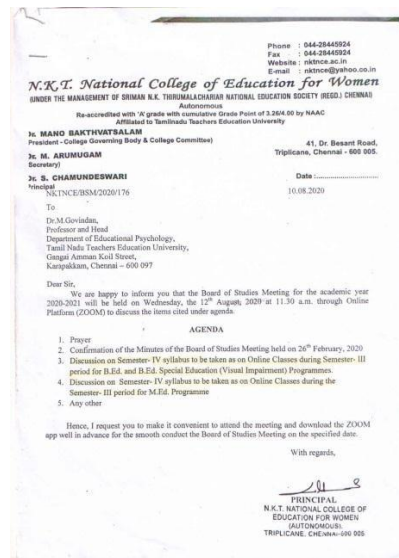
The Alumni of the College are vibrant and are actively involved in all phases of the functioning of the College: Planning, Implementation and Evaluation.
