### Role of Alumni in Institutional Functioning

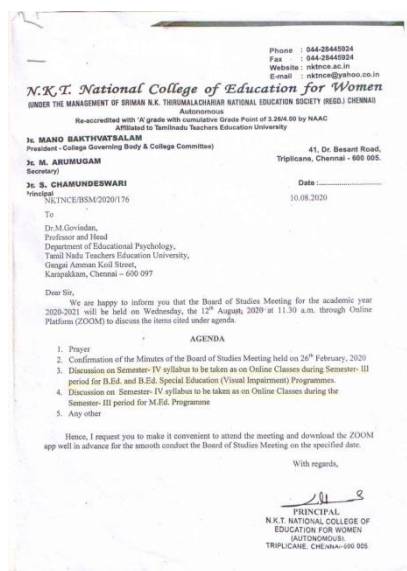

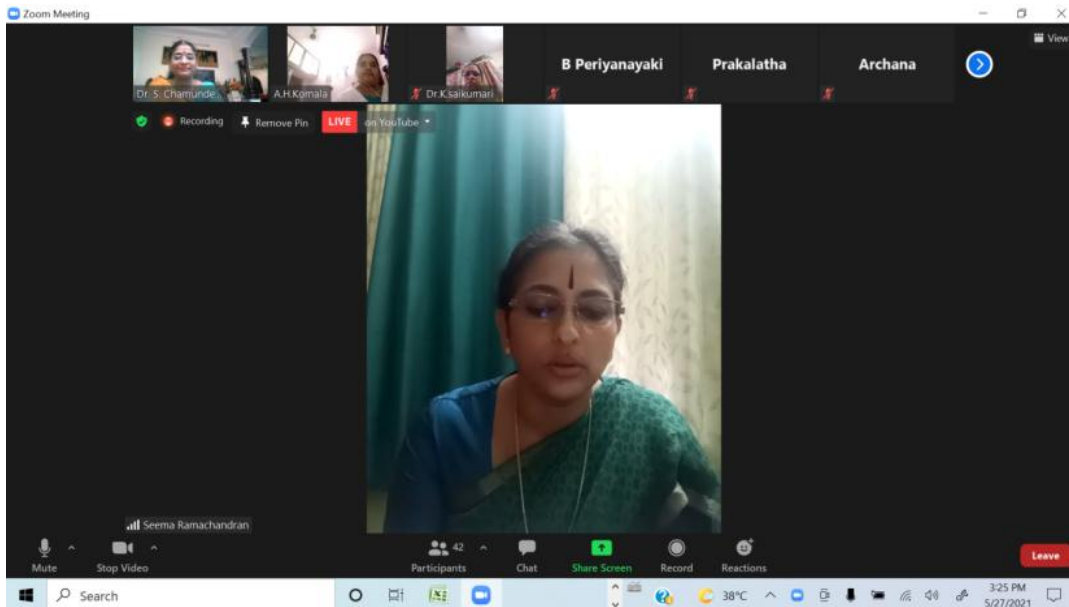
