Preamble

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between, SRI SAI SWARUPA'S T.A.R'S SCHOOL Beside ILTD, Sai Baba Temple ANAPARTHI- 533342 and N.K.T. NATIONAL COLLEGE OF EDUCATION FOR WOMEN (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai 600005. This Memorandum of Understanding has been executed at Chennai on 16th December, 2022 through the Chief functionaries of the parties.

I. Sri Sai Swarupa's T.A.R'S School was established in the year 2004 by Shri T.Appa Reddy, honourable Chairman with a vision to give best quality education to the children in and around the rural areas of Anaparathi. The school works under the motto – AIM, ACHIEVE AND TRIUMPH. The School is located in a five acre spacious, airy and pollution free environment. The school building is built in two acres and the remaining three acres are dedicated to a spacious play area. The school believes that sports are a crucial part of a student's growth and development. Through participation in games and sports, a student gains various skills, experience and confidence that are helpful for developing their personality. The school values are: → A high standard of teaching and learning. → A safe and welcoming environment. → A family and community involvement. The school offers an inquiry based, child centered and academically rigorous curriculum that addresses the intellectual, social and emotional needs of each child. From Nursery to Grade 5th , the school follows Primary Year's Program under integrated syllabus. From Grade 6th to Grade 10th , A.P State Board curriculum is being followed. Our aim is to train young minds with quality and virtue to be leaders playing a vital role in bringing about the desired changes for the betterment of the society. The language of instruction and inclusion at the school is English. Students are frequently involved in curriculum related field trips and opportunities to learn from experts within the community. Promoting the harmony across all communities, special assemblies are conducted on a regular basis where all the festivals, irrespective of the religion are fondly celebrated. The school is striving to foresee a world of universal singularity where our children are going to be a propellant of this change and the world shall be beautiful place to live in.

II. N.K.T. National College of Education for Women is situated at the heart of the Chennai city, at Triplicane. The College is built in an area of 3.06 acres, where a model school is also housed. Established in the year 1966 by Sriman N.K Thirumalachariar, a visionary and a philanthropist, it has evolved into a well established College catering to the Teacher Education needs of women from all sections of the society. The College offers graduate and postgraduate courses in Education with Autonomous status awarded by the University Grants Commission in the year 1988. In thirty four years after Autonomy, the College has grown upright to great heights as an institution of higher learning in Education. N.K.T. National College of Education for Women has also fallen in line with to NAAC peer team evaluation and it was awarded a Five Star status in the First Cycle and awarded A Grade with CGPA of 3.26 on a 4 point scale in the Second Cycle. The College, in this 56th year of its existence, with 34 years of autonomy, remains fully aware and committed to its mission of empowering young women student teachers to face life and its multifarious challenges at both personal and professional levels. The College offers B.Ed., B.Ed. Special Education (VI), M.Ed. and M.Phil. Programmes with recognition from National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), Bangalore and Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), New Delhi.

1. Purpose and Objectives

The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and interaction towards the empowerment and providing placement for teacher graduates. Hence, the parties desired to work together with the following objectives:

- ❖ To provide available information on jobs, positions, opportunities related to teaching;
- ❖ To provide career guidance about avenues open after graduation in Teacher Education;
- ❖ To conduct workshops, seminars and special activities to assist students in career planning;
- ❖ To enhance employment opportunities and foster partnerships with Educational Institutions to facilitate On- and Off campus recruitments;
- ❖ To empower students with communicative abilities and leadership qualities;
- ❖ To equip students with interview and life coping skills to face interviews with ease and confidence;
- ❖ To enable students to be placed in the right job under suitable employers;
- ❖ To plan and organize "Recruits Pursuit" in campus;
- ❖ To bridge between potential recruiters and academia;
- ❖ To manage correspondence and feedback of recruiters;

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

- 2.1. That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Principal of Sri Sai Swarupa's T.A.R'S School & Principal of N.K.T. National College of Education for Women;
- 2.2. That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is

subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties/Institutions;

- 2.3. Sri Sai Swarupa's T.A.R'S School and N.K.T. National College of Education for Women agree that this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual agreement and that each institution may unilaterally withdraw after three months' notice to the partner;
- 2.4. The functionaries shall meet at least once in three months for planning and implementation of the School Internship and other activities via video conference / face to face mode;


This Memorandum of Understanding was signed on 16th December, 2022 by the designated authorities of both the parties
