## ABOUT OUR FOUNDER

Our Founder, Thiru. N.K. Thirumalachariar, who led humankind toward excellence through his untiring educational efforts, was responsible for starting the National Training College for Women, at present termed as the N.K.T. National College of Education for Women.

Born on September 17<sup>th</sup> 1895, in a small village of Thirunelveli District, he became a lawyer and was admitted to the Bar in the year 1919. He had an inborn inclination for public service, which was realized through his educational service.

The present N.K.T. National Girls' Higher Secondary School was started by him as an Elementary School in the year 1941, which soon grew to become a Middle School, a High School and a Higher Secondary School.

In order to produce efficient teachers he started the N.K.T. National Training College for Women in the year 1966. Ever since its inception, the College is doing extraordinarily well, winning honors year after year. Over a period of 59 years, the College has expanded and enriched the scope of trained teachers.

The secret of his success in the field of educational service was the tremendous amount of conviction he had in love, service, sacrifice, charity and piety. These institutions are ever indebted to him for their present status.

16. Students are expected to utilize their free time profitably and should not be found loitering anywhere in the College campus, during the working hours.
17. Students must refrain from engaging in malpractices during Examinations. If found guilty, they will be barred from appearing for future examinations.
18. Students should pay their fees on time.
19. Ragging of any kind is punishable and will be strictly dealt with.
20. Use of mobile phones while in classrooms is strictly prohibited.
21. Students must avoid carrying valuables to College. The College will not take responsibility for property lost.
22. Students are expected to keep the College campus clean and green.
23. Students should take utmost care in safeguarding College property. Damage of any sort will be considered as a breach of discipline and severely dealt with.

24. Food and beverages are not permitted inside the classrooms and laboratories and must be taken in the lunch room only.
25. Students are allowed to bring their vehicles only up to the designated parking area of the College. Entry beyond this point is strictly prohibited.
26. No student shall collect any money or contribution in cash or kind for any activity without prior permission from the Head of the Institution.
27. Severe disciplinary action will be taken against those, who in any way, disturb the decorum of the College.
28. Prior permission should be obtained from the Head of the Institution, in order to be a part of any activity pertaining to intercollegiate competitions, social media or press.
29. The Institution prohibits political activities of any kind in the College campus and forbids students from conducting and attending political meetings under the College banner.
30. The Head of the Institution is the ultimate disciplinary authority in the College.

### **Code of Conduct for Student-Teachers during School Internship**

1. Each Student-teacher shall be subject to the disciplinary regulations of the School where she is undergoing her Internship.
2. Student-teachers are expected to greet the Principal and other faculty members with reverence within and outside the School premises.
3. Student-teachers should conduct themselves in an ethical manner.
4. Student-teachers should function as their mentor guides them.
5. Student-teacher must dress modestly and maintain the decorum of the school.
6. Student-teachers must be adequately prepared with their subject content.
7. Student-teachers must handle classes in a professional manner.
8. Every Student-teacher shall volunteer to participate in all activities of the school.

## **Code of Conduct for Teaching Faculty Members**

1. Every Teacher shall discharge her/his duties diligently and keep up to the academic standards and performance norms laid down by the College Management and the statutory bodies in Higher Education.
2. Every Teacher shall update herself/himself professionally for the effective discharge of duties assigned to her/him.
3. Every Teacher shall conduct herself/himself with absolute dignity and decorum in dealing with her/his superiors, colleagues and students.
4. No Teacher shall accept any token or other assignment given to her/him by any external agency without the prior permission of the College Management.
5. No Teacher shall associate with any political party or take part in any other organizational actively, which is not in line with the duties and ethics of the teaching profession.
6. No Teacher shall participate in any strike or demonstration against the College Management or the Government for any reason whatsoever.
7. No Teacher shall act in any manner that violates the norms of decency or morality in her/his conduct or behavior inside and outside the College Campus.
8. No Teacher shall incite, provoke or instigate any students or any other member of the faculty into any form of action against the College Management.
9. No Teacher shall by deed, degrade, harass or insult any other person for any reason whatsoever, or act in a manner unbecoming of the teaching profession.
10. Every Teacher, should at all times, strive for academic excellence in the discharge of her/his duties and conduct herself/himself in a manner for all to emulate.
11. The College Management may, at its sole discretion, provide an opportunity to the faculty member for presenting her/his case through a personal hearing before taking a final decision. The decision of the College Management will be deemed final and binding and will not be subject to any appeal to any individual or forum.

## **Code of Conduct for the Employees in the College**

1. Every Staff employed in the College shall discharge her/his duties efficiently and diligently and shall conform to the rules and regulations of the College.
2. No Staff employed in the College shall absent herself/himself from her/his duties without prior permission from her/his authorities. In the event of a medical emergency, however, a medical certificate to the satisfaction of the College authorities shall be produced within a week of taking leave.
3. No Staff employed in the College shall engage directly or indirectly in any trade or business. In the case of remunerative work, specific sanction of the College authorities, in writing, shall be obtained.
4. No Staff employed in the College shall send any application for employment to any other agency, except through the Secretary of the College.
5. The relieving order of the Staff shall be open to the College Committee and they can decide on the same.
6. When a Staff employed in the College, seeks to accept honorary work without detriment to her/his duties, prior permission of the Secretary, in writing, should be obtained.
7. A Staff employed in the College, when involved in criminal proceedings, should inform the committee of such proceedings.
8. No Staff employed in the College, shall engage herself/himself in any political activity. She/He shall not associate with any political party or any organization which takes part in politics or subscribe to, or assist in any other manner, any political movement.
9. No Staff employed in the College shall contest or participate in or canvas for any candidate in any election.
10. No Staff employed in the College shall bring or attempt to bring any political or other influence on her/his superior authority in respect of her/his individual service interests.
11. No Staff employed in the College shall engage herself/himself, nor participate in any activity which is anti-secular or prejudicial to the Sovereignty and Integrity of India, or that which involves contempt of court, defamation or incitement to an offence.
12. No Staff employed in the College shall indulge in any criticism of the policies of the Government either directly or indirectly or participate in activities which bring disrespect to the Government.

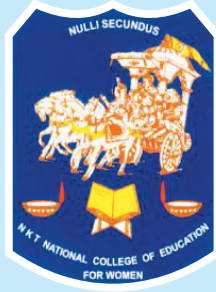
