Our Founder, Sriman.N.K.Thirumalachariar, who lead human kind towards excellence through his untiring educational efforts, was responsible for starting the National Training College for Women, at present called as the N.K.T. National College of Education for women.

Born on September 17th 1895, in a small village of Thirunelveli District, he became a lawyer and was admitted to the Bar in the year 1919. National Girls' Higher Secondary School was started by him as an elementary school in the year 1941 which soon grew to become a middle school, a high school and higher secondary school.
