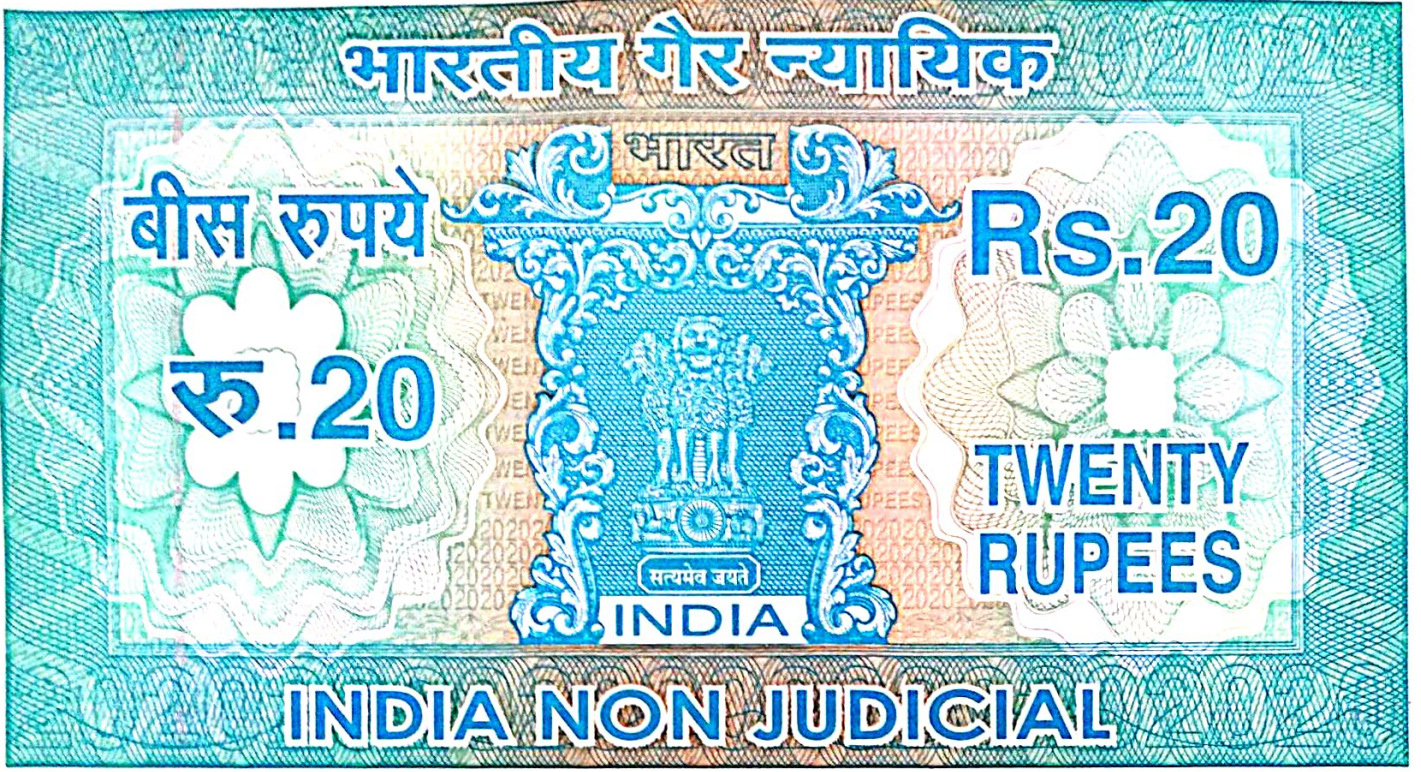

Preamble

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between, N.K.T. National College of Education for Women (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai 600 005 and PG and Research Department of English, Justice Basheer Ahmed Sayeed College for Women (Autonomous), Chennai 600 018. This Memorandum of Understanding has been executed at Chennai on 30th October 2024 through the Chief functionaries of the parties.

I. N.K.T. National College of Education for Women is situated at the heart of the Chennai city, at Triplicane. The College is built in an area of 3.06 acres, where a model school is also housed. Established in the year 1966 by Sriman N.K Thirumalachariar, a visionary and a philanthropist, it has evolved into a well-established College catering to the Teacher Education needs of women from all sections of the society. The College offers graduate and postgraduate courses in Education with Autonomous status awarded by the University Grants Commission in the year 1988. In thirty six years after Autonomy, the College has grown upright to great heights as an Institution of higher learning in Education. N.K.T. National College of Education for Women has also fallen in line with the NAAC peer team evaluation and was awarded a Five Star status in the First Cycle, A Grade in the Second Cycle and A+ Grade in the Third Cycle. In its continuous striving for excellence over five decades in achieving position '**Second to None**', the Institution has been successful and has been upgrading its curricula and pedagogy on par with the global standards with the vision of transforming students to global educators.

The College, in this 58th year of its existence, with 36 years of Autonomy, remains fully aware and committed to its mission of empowering young women student-teachers to face life and its multifarious challenges at both personal and professional levels.

II. Justice Basheer Ahmed Sayeed College for Women (formerly known as the S.I.E.T Women's College) was established in 1955 with the aim of imparting higher education to women. The institution is maintained by the Southern India Education Trust and was founded by Justice Basheer Ahmed Sayeed who dedicated his life in nurturing women of integrity and intellect. This Women's College is situated in Chennai, Tamil Nadu and occupies as much as 13 acres of land, being accredited by NAAC. The College has been accredited the five star level by the National Assessment Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 1999, re-accredited at Grade 'A+' level in 2007, re-accredited (Third Cycle) at 'A' Grade with CGPA: 3.61 in 2013 and re-accredited (Fourth Cycle) at 'A++' Grade with CGPA: 3.58 in 2022. JBAS College has a cumulative enrolment of 7, 247 students and 297 faculties. They offer 59 courses across 12 degrees. The Justice Basheer Ahmed Sayeed College for Women empowers students through a diverse range of undergraduate and postgraduate programs. Explore academic fields in Arts, Sciences, Commerce, and Management. Undergraduate options include established subjects such as Economics, History, Political Science, and English alongside specialized programs in Plant Biotechnology, Interior Design, and Nutrition. Postgraduate programs offer further specialization in areas like Applied Psychology, Home Science, and Corporate Economics. The College fosters advanced research through M.Phil. and Ph.D. opportunities in select disciplines with a focus on academic excellence and character development, the College

provides a holistic education. The institution's inclusive environment fosters cultural exchange and spiritual growth, empowering students to make a positive impact on society.

1. Purpose and Objectives

The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and interaction towards the empowerment of the students. Hence, the parties desired to work together with the following objectives:

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered between NKT National College of Education and P G and Research Department of English, JBAS College for Women to explore collaborations for increasing the academic output and strengthening the Institutions for mutual benefit. This is an intended agreement to:

- 1.1. *Develop academic and educational cooperation which will facilitate exchange of Faculty members, Scholars, Student-Teacher Educators, Student-Teachers for Short Term Courses ensuing Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) by transfer of credits, conduct collaborative Research Projects, organize Lectures, Seminars, Workshops and Symposia for exchange of academic expertise;*
- 1.2. *Conduct and organize Programme integrations without financial dependencies;*
- 1.3. *Encourage opportunities for Global openings and other possibilities without any financial dependencies;*
- 1.4. *Encourage and emphasis the Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors and others to participate and contribute as Resource Faculty;*
- 1.5. *Establish a global stage for the Students/ Teachers; and*
- 1.6. *Strengthen the educational relationship between N.K.T. National College of Education for Women (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai 600 005 and Justice Basheer Ahmed Sayeed College for Women (Autonomous), Teynampet, Chennai 600 018 for the welfare of students.*

2. Discretion:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is subject to the following:

- 2.1 *That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Secretary/ Principal of N.K.T. National College of Education for Women (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai 600 005 and P.G and Research Department of English, Justice Basheer Ahmed Sayeed College for Women (Autonomous), Teynampet, Chennai 600 018. That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for Three (3) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties/Institutions.*
- 2.2 *N.K.T. National College of Education for Women (Autonomous), Triplicane, Chennai 600 005 and PG and Research Department of English, Justice Basheer Ahmed Sayeed College for Women (Autonomous), Teynampet, Chennai 600 018 agree that this Memorandum of*

Understanding may be mutual agreement and that each Institution may unilaterally withdraw after six months notice to the partner.

2.3 *The functionaries shall meet at least once in three months for planning and implementation of the programmes via video conference or face to face based on everyone's availability.*

This Memorandum of Understanding was signed on 30th October 2024, by the designated authorities of both the parties.
