

Agenda 1: IQAC Meeting


The Principal asked the Faculty Members in-charge of IQAC Meetings to prepare and get ready for the next Quarterly IQAC Meeting.

Agenda 2: Maintenance of Infrastructure

The Principal insisted all the Faculty members to maintain the infrastructure of the classrooms and to check whether all the technologies are working properly. The in-charge staffs of each room were asked to check their room arrangements regularly.

Agenda 3: Teaching Practice

Before coming to College they should also finish all the formalities in the schools where they are going for Teaching Practice and it was also suggested that they will continue their lessons as Peer Teaching in the College.


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Agenda 4: Outcome of Statutory Body Meetings

The Principal discussed with Faculty members the outcome of Statutory Body Meetings, Board of Studies held on 12th August 2020, Academic Council held on 18th December 2020 and the College Governing Body Meeting held on 24th February 2021. She informed the approval granted for swapping of Semesters-III & IV for the B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education Programmes and for conducting the Semester-III Practical Examinations of Bachelors and Masters Programmes at the end of Semester-IV.


Agenda 6: Discussion on arrangements for Symposium on NAAC SSR Preparation

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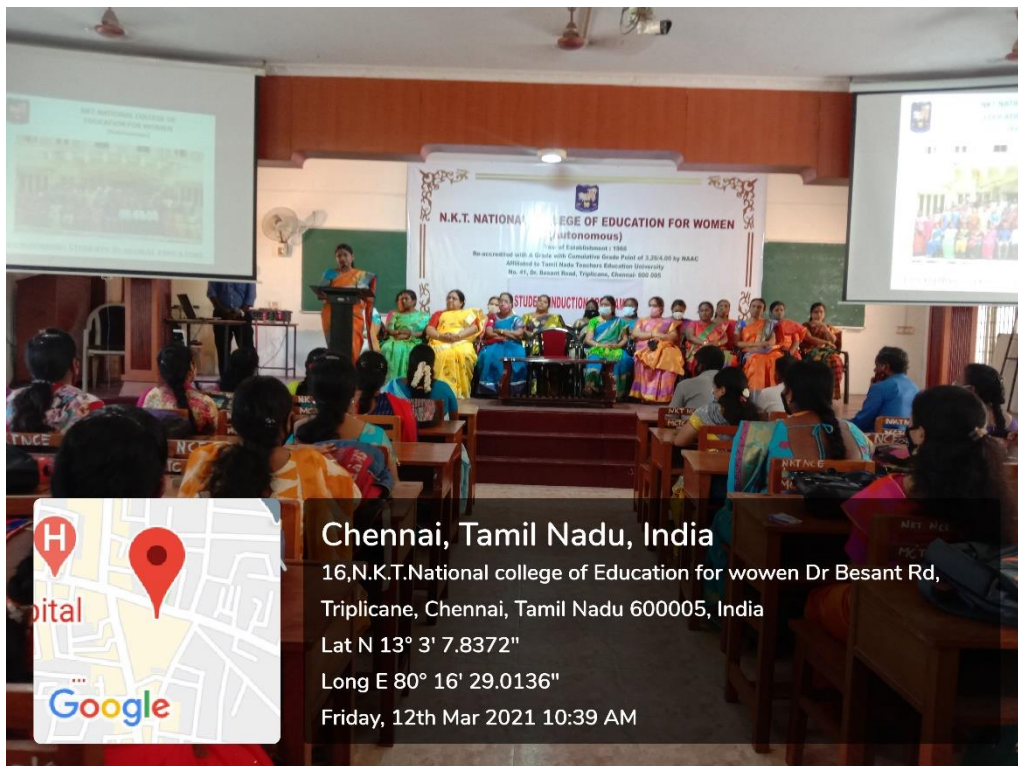

Student Induction Programme for 2020-2022 Batch Students addressed by the Principal, Dr. S. Chamundeswari on 12th March 2021

Due to the global pandemic situation, Single Window Counselling for admission of students could commence only by 8th March 2021. The Student Induction Programme for the 2020-2022 Batch of B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education students was scheduled on 12th March, 2021 to help new students to familiarize and feel the new environment, familiarize them with the Vision, Mission and culture of the Institution and to help them build bonds with other students and faculty members.

The Principal of the College, Dr. S. Chamundeswari, was present along with all Teaching Faculty Members and Non-teaching Staff. The Programme started with a prayer, followed by Thamizh Thai Vazthu. The Principal welcomed the Faculty, Non-teaching Staff and newly admitted students for the academic year 2020-2021.

She shared the rich history of the Institution, which is situated at the heart of the Chennai city at Triplicane. It is built in an area of 3.06 acres, where a model school is also housed. Established in the year 1966 by Sriman N.K. Thirumalachariar, a visionary and a philanthropist, the Institution has evolved into a well-established College, committed to its mission of empowering young women student-teachers to face life and its multifarious challenges at both personal and professional levels.

The College offers Graduate, Postgraduate and Research Programmes in Education with Autonomous status awarded by the University Grants Commission in the year 1988. In thirty-three years of Autonomy, the College has grown upright to great heights as an institution of higher learning in Education.

Today, N.K.T. National College of Education has close to 600 students, enrolled in B.Ed., B.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment), M.Ed., M.Phil. and Ph.D. in Education and it has acquired a reputation for excellence, inclusiveness and committed service to the teaching community. In its continuous striving for excellence, over five decades in achieving position '**Second to None**', the institution has been successful.

N.K.T. National College of Education for Women has also fallen in line with NAAC Peer Team Evaluation and it was awarded a five-star status in the first cycle and re-

accredited at A Grade with CGPA of 3.26 on a 4-point scale, in the second cycle and the due for the third cycle accreditation.

Research is our stronghold around which our College is continuously evolving. The Autonomous Status of the College opens up a great scope for upgrading our Teacher Education Curriculum to the current needs of the society. Our focus is to prepare our teachers to rise up to the challenges of School Education and to have a holistic outlook of Education.
