*It is unanimously resolved to approve and pass the Minutes of the Board of Studies Meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2023.*

**Item No. 3: Discussion to include the topic Artificial Intelligence in B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education Curricula**

The Principal invited Dr. V. Jayashree Priyadharsini, Dean of Academics, to justify the need to include Artificial Intelligence in the B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education Curricula.

Dr. V. Jayashree Priyadharsini explained that based on the analysis of feedback from stakeholders and suggestions from the members of the Board of Studies, the need to introduce Artificial Intelligence was felt important and therefore it is suggested to include the topic in Semester-I under Unit-III of the Course, PE3a – Learning and Teaching – Part-I in B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment) Curricula.

Prof. S. Senthilnathan, University Nominee suggested students to undergo AI For ALL a Self Learning Online Programme for better understanding of the concept.

After seeking necessary clarifications, it was unanimously agreed to introduce the topic Artificial Intelligence in B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education Programmes and to pass the following resolution.

**Resolution No 2:**

*It is unanimously resolved by the members of the Academic Council to approve the inclusion of the topic Artificial Intelligence in Semester-I, under the course PE3a Learning and Teaching Part-I from the academic year 2023-2024 onwards in the B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education Programmes.*

**Item No. 4: Discussion to include the topic Augmented and Virtual Reality in B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education Curricula**

The Principal once again invited Dr. V. Jayashree Priyadharsini to justify the need to include Augmented and Virtual Reality in the B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education Curricula.

Dr. V. Jayashree Priyadharsini explained that the recent advancement in the field of technology has induced the need for inclusion of the topic Augmented and Virtual Reality in Semester-I under Unit-V

of the Course, CPS2a – Pedagogy of School Subjects in B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment) Curricula.

Prof. S. Semthilnahan suggested graded inclusion of topics pertaining to technology like Augmented and Virtual Reality to facilitate appropriateness in pedagogy curricula



**Resolution No. 4**
