The meeting commenced with a silent prayer and the Principal welcomed the Secretary of the College, Dr. M. Arumugam and all members present for the meeting.

The Principal thanked and placed on record her gratitude to the Hon. Secretary of the College for all his unconditional support and guidance for adhering to the code of conduct by all Teaching Faculty members, Non-Teaching Staff and Students.

The Principal addressed that all College Employees are expected to follow general rules and guidelines and must treat everyone with respect, patience, integrity, courtesy, dignity and consideration. Use positive reinforcement rather than criticism, inappropriate competition, or comparison when working with students. She added that who ever adopts teaching as a profession assumes the obligation to conduct himself/ herself in accordance with the ideals of the profession. A teacher is constantly under the scrutiny of his /her students and the society at large. Therefore, every teacher should see that there is no incompatibility between his/ her precepts and practices.

The code reflects the vision, mission and value framework of the College, and it exists to guide conduct, safeguarding and promoting the academic and outreach activities of the College.

Principal addressed that the Teaching Faculty members are being apprised of the Code of Conduct during the Teacher Orientation Programme on Annual Pedagogical Plan, the Non-Teaching Staff during the Non-Teaching Staff Annual Orientation Programme and Students during the Student Induction Programme and Student Orientation Programme on Strategies for Effective Student Teaching Internship. In addition the Code of Conduct to be followed by all in the campus is also posted in the College Website.


Principal informed that during the last academic year 2022-2023 the major issue that rose was that some students consistently reported late to College in the morning. They were not able to attend the morning assembly and give attendance at the correct time. The issue was discussed with students along with the NKT Student Union and Faculty members. Students apologized for coming late to College and explained that due to construction of Metro at various places inside the City of Chennai they were delayed because of heavy traffic blocks. It was informed to the Committee that students were advised to start a little early to avoid such traffic blocks and discipline themselves to report to College on correct time as they have to train themselves to be punctual in the Teaching Profession.

Faculty members also informed that a few students were following the correct dress code by not wearing their dhuppattas on top. But when advised they disciplined themselves to follow the correct dress code.

Principal reported her utmost satisfaction pertaining to the code of conduct maintained by all employees and students at the campus and she placed on record her appreciation to all Teaching Faculty members, Non-Teaching Staff, NKT Student Union and members of the Parent-Teacher Association who had extended their cooperation for maintenance of code of conduct in the College during the last academic year 2022-2023.

The Secretary of the College, Dr. M. Arumugam placed on record his appreciation to the Principal, Teaching Faculty members, Non-Teaching staff and Students for maintaining complete discipline and supporting students to maintain discipline and decorum both at College and at Internship Schools.
